

# Rangers planned works (first quarter 2026)

Bus stop cleaning and graffiti removal.

All are identified and running in a rotation at the discretion of the operatives.

Several twittens in various wards are slowly being cleared; approximately 23 have been identified, in various states of degradation.

Road signs and directional signs are planned for cleaning around the town with regard to road safety and in consultation with ESH.

5 Town planters have now been taken on, and a planned planting and flora maintenance program will be put in place to ensure a yearly/seasonal rotation is visible.

Over the winter /spring months, there is a planned renovation to take place at Norman's Bay toilet block involving painting and a small amount of building work. And garden renovation.

Planned maintenance of the Watermill road allotments is work in progress and continues seasonally.

Ongoing toilet renovation works at Normans bay toilet for Easter opening.

Repair work on the conservation bus shelter at Gunters Lane

Ongoing renovations of the Channel View East toilet block

Grounds maintenance at the Watermill lane allotment site, planned implementation of a natural Bee garden and wild flower area

Planned renovation of the inside of Cooden sea road toilet for the purpose of creating a temporary working area.

Renovation of the little common roundabout disabled toilet door.

Ongoing renovation of the pathway through Collington woods as reported by Cllr Peters

Refurbishment of Ninfield Road sign , Lunsford Cross.

Path clearing and cleaning of Holliers Hill (cllr Lee)

Path clearing and cleaning outside King Offa Main School ( Cllr Lee)

The above duties and commitments are subject to many factors, including staff availability and weather, which of course, during the winter months hampers a lot of outside remedial work.

## **Bexhill-on-Sea Town Rangers Planned Works and Work in Progress Report**

### Summary

This report outlines the planned works and ongoing projects managed by the Town Rangers in Bexhill-on-Sea for the first quarter of 2026. The following activities are designed to enhance the town's aesthetics, safety, and overall community well-being.

#### 7. Ongoing Toilet Renovation Works at Norman's Bay

- Our team is focused on renovations at the Norman's Bay toilet to ensure readiness for the Easter opening.

#### 8. Gunters Lane Conservation Bus Shelter Repair

- Repair work is being conducted on the conservation bus shelter located at Gunters Lane.

#### 9. Channel View East Toilet Block Renovations

- Renovations at the Channel View East toilet block are ongoing, aimed at improving facilities for residents and visitors.

#### 10. Grounds Maintenance and Bee Garden Implementation

- Ongoing grounds maintenance at the Watermill Lane allotments includes the planned establishment of a natural bee garden and wildflower area.

#### 11. Cooden Sea Road Toilet Renovation

- Planned renovations for the interior of the Cooden Sea Road toilet are intended to create a temporary working area.

#### 12. Little Common Roundabout Disabled Toilet Door Renovation

- Renovation works for the disabled toilet door at the Little Common roundabout are scheduled.

- Ongoing renovations of the pathway through Collington Woods, as reported by Councillor Peters, are in progress.

#### 14. Ninfield Road Sign Refurbishment

- Refurbishment of the Ninfield Road sign at Lunsford Cross is planned to improve visibility and community standards.

- Path clearing and cleaning initiatives are underway at:

- Outside King Offa Main School (as reported by Councillor Lee)
